The license is not assignable or transferable. A retailer shall conspicuously display the license at each retail location in a manner visible to the public.

Violation Code - Tobacco retailers must be licensed by the California State Department of Tax and Fee Administration (CDTFA) for each tobacco retail location. The license shall be conspicuously displayed at each retail location in a manner visible to the public.

SUMMARY OF THE CORRESPONDING LAWS AND REGULATIONS FOR THE VIOLATIONS LISTED ON THE FRONT SIDE OF THIS FORM. THIS SUMMARY PAGE LISTS THE GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR EACH ITEM. THE DEPARTMENT MAY CITE ADDITIONAL SECTIONS AS APPLICABLE.

- 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to act as a tobacco retailer without first obtaining and maintaining a valid tobacco retailer's permit for each location at which tobacco retailing is to occur.
- Tobacco retailers must be licensed by the California State Department of Tax and Fee Administration (CDTFA) for each tobacco retail location. For
 the purposes of this law, a "retailer" is someone who sells tobacco products from a building or a vending machine. The license is not assignable or
 transferable. A retailer shall conspicuously display the license at each retail location in a manner visible to the public.
- 3. Every store that sells tobacco must post a boldly-printed, contrasting color sign in a conspicuous place at each point of purchase saying that tobacco products may not be sold to persons under 21 years of age. The sign must state that retailers must check the identification of anyone who reasonably appears to be under 21 years of age. The sign must contain the following words: "The Sale of Tobacco Products to Persons Under 21 Years of Age Is Prohibited by Law and Subject to Penalties. Valid Identification May Be Required. To Report an Unlawful Tobacco Sale Call 1-800-5 ASK-4-ID. Business and Professions Code section 22952." The sign must be square (at least 5.5 inches by 5.5 inches) or rectangular (3.66 inches by 8.5 inches), and the required notice must meet specified font sizes.
- 4. It is unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to sell, give, or in any way furnish to a person under 21 years of age any tobacco product or paraphernalia if that person, firm, or corporation knows or should have grounds to know that the recipient is under 21 years of age. Proof that a retailer, or his or her employee or agent, demanded, was shown, and reasonably relied upon evidence of legal age (such as identification) shall be a defense to any action.
- 5. No person shall engage in tobacco retailing, if the person is below the age of 18.
- 6. No person shall sell, offer for sale, distribute, or import any tobacco product commonly referred to as "bidis" or "beedies," unless that tobacco product is sold, offered for sale, or intended to be sold in a business establishment that prohibits the presence of persons under 21 years of age on its premises.
- 7. No person shall engage in tobacco retailing from a location other than a fixed location. Tobacco retailing by persons on foot or from a vehicle is prohibited.
- 8. It is unlawful for a person engaged in the retail sale of tobacco products to sell, offer for sale, or display for sale any tobacco product or tobacco paraphernalia by self-service display. *Exception:* Tobacco-only stores may make available by self-service display pipe tobacco, snuff, chewing tobacco, dipping tobacco, and cigars that are generally not sold or offered for sale in a sealed package of the manufacturer or importer containing fewer than six cigars. Tobacco-only stores are defined as stores that make more than 60% of gross annual revenue from the sale of tobacco products and paraphernalia, that prohibit unaccompanied minors, and that do not sell alcohol or food for consumption on the premises. The installation, storage and/or operation of cigarette or tobacco vending machines within the County is prohibited.
- 9. It is unlawful for any person, agent, or employee of a person in the business of selling or distributing smokeless tobacco or cigarettes to engage in the nonsale distribution of any smokeless tobacco or cigarettes to any person in any public building, park or playground, or on any public sidewalk, street, or other public grounds, or on any private property that is open to the general public. "Nonsale distribution" means to give smokeless tobacco or cigarettes to the general public at no cost, or at nominal cost, or to give coupons, coupon offers, gift certificates, gift cards, or other similar offers, or rebate offers for smokeless tobacco or cigarettes to the general public at no cost or at nominal cost.
- 10. No person may sell one or more cigarettes, other than in a sealed and properly labeled package. A sealed and properly labeled package means the original packaging of the manufacturer or importer which meets federal labeling requirements, including the federal warning label. Cigarettes may not be manufactured, distributed, sold, or offered for sale except in a package containing at least 20 cigarettes. Roll-your-own tobacco may not be manufactured, distributed, sold, or offered for sale except in a package containing at least 0.60 ounces of tobacco.
